**One author:**

Kinney, J. (2007). *Diary of a wimpy kid*. Camberwell, VIC: Puffin Books.

**In-text citation:**

(Kinney, 2007).

**Two authors:**

Crew, G., & Wilson, M. (2002). *The castaways of the Charles Eaton*. Melbourne, VIC: Thomas C. Lothian Pty. Ltd.

**In-text citation:**

(Crew & Wilson, 2002)

**Three to six authors:**

The first six authors are listed. Others are shortened to et al.

**No author or editor named:**

Place the title in the author position.

**Item in a series:**

Healey, J. (Ed.). (2007). *Child poverty*. In *Issues in Society*: v. 264. Thirroul, NSW: The Spinney Press.

**In-text citation:**

(Healey, 2007).

**Weekly magazine article:**

Cloud, J. (2008, June 30). Not separate, just equal. *Time*, 25, 9.

Author. (Year, Date). Title of article. *Journal*, Issue Number, page number.

**In-text citation:**

(Cloud, 2008).

**Newspaper article:**

Miranda, C., & Davies, L. (2008, June 24). Helping crims get out of jail. *The Daily Telegraph*, p. 13.

Use this format if you have read the actual article in the actual paper.

**In-text citation:**

(Miranda & Davies, 2008).

**Online newspaper article:**

Ramachandran, A. (2008, June 26). Fury as DOCS 'lose' girl. *The Sydney Morning Herald*. Retrieved June 26, 2008, from <http://www.smh.com.au/news/national/fury-as-docs-lose-girl/2008/06/26/1214073392848.html>.

**In-text citation:**

(Ramachandran, 2008, ¶1). Use the ¶ symbol to indicate the paragraph number for a direct quote.

**Letter to the editor:**

Reed, L. (2008, June 26). [Letter to the editor]. *The Sydney Morning Herald*, p. 35.

**In-text citation:**

(Reed, 2008).
